

FSU netters open with 9-0 win

Florida State opened its tennis season at Tully Courts Friday with a 9-0 victory over Boston College, being forced to three sets in only three of nine matches.

No. 1 Jose Neto defeated Jack Officer 6-2, 6-1 in the feature singles match, then teamed with Allen Bellamy to beat Kevin Nawn and Rick Ryan 6-4, 6-3 in doubles.
