

## FSU gains narrow win in tennis

The Florida State men's tennis team squeaked out a 5-4 win over Appalachian State Tuesday at the Tully Courts.

The Seminoles trailed 4-3 in matches and 4-2 in the third set tiebreaker of the first doubles, but Jose Neto and Alan Bellamy rallied to win the set. Then the team of Steve Layton and Peter Prinos won the second doubles set 2-6, 7-6, 7-5 to clinch the match.

FSU is now 6-3, while Appalachian State fell to 6-3. The team hosts Southern Illinois Thursday at 2 p.m.
