

FSU entries fall in tennis tourney

ATHENS, Ga. — Florida State's Marco Abilhoa defeated Miland Raud of Georgia Tech 6-3, 6-4 in the first round of the 13th Annual Southern Intercollegiate Singles Championship at the University of Georgia.

However, Abilhoa lost in the second round to Georgia's Tom Foster 7-5, 6-3. In other first-round matches involving FSU players, Hernan Luque lost to Andy Avram of Wake Forest 6-2, 6-4; Darryl Weiner was defeated by Allen Farfour of Wake Forest 6-1, 6-1; and John McLean lost to fifth-seeded Pender Murphy of Clemson 6-3, 6-4.

Top-seeded Mark Dickson of Clemson and No. 2 Fred Sauer of Miami won their opening matches, but third-ranked Peter Floyd of host Georgia was upset in straight sets.

Unseeded Jay Horine of Virginia downed Floyd 6-4, 6-4. Dickson dropped the first set to Gerald Kleis 6-1, but rebounded 6-3, 6-3. Sauer turned back another Georgia entry, Lane Curlee, 6-2, 7-6.
