

FSU defeats Southwest Louisiana

Florida State lost only one singles and two doubles matches to Southwest Louisiana Friday at the Speicher Center. Seminole No. 1

seed Brian Stanton had a difficult time with Southwest Louisiana's Steven Parks, losing 7-6, 7-0.

No. 2 seeded Antonia Prieto won 6-2, 7-5 against Southwest Louisiana's Greg Zgola. FSU's Ken McKenzie defeated Hughes Lavediere 6-2, 6-3 for in the No. 3 match. No. 4 Murphy Payne won 6-2, 6-1 against Billy Gluck of Southwest Louisiana. No. 5 seeded Murphy Payne won 6-3, 7-5 over Dario Napoli and No. 6 Alex Golub won 6-3, 4-6, 7-5 over Cade Resnick.
