

DUKE DEFEATS FLORIDA STATE 4-0, ADVANCES TO NCAA FINAL 16

CLEMSON, SC--Duke won three singles matches in straight sets after winning the doubles point as the Blue Devils defeated Florida State 4-0 in the NCAA Region II Men's Tennis Tournament at Clemson, SC Saturday.

With the win, Duke will advance to the NCAA Tournament's Final 16 in Athens, GA next weekend.

Duke, ranked 10th in the nation, improves its record to 20-5 overall, while Florida State ends its season with a 15-13 record overall.

The match was finished indoors after inclement weather moved into the Clemson, SC area.
