

# The Duke University Blue Devils

ils. rated by many as the outstanding track team in the Southern Conference this season, proved they deserve that rating here yesterday afternoon by chalking up eight new track records while defeating the Florida State University Seminoles 103 to 28. The defeat was the worst ever suffered by a Florida State team.

Tom Sebring, former Leon High school athlete from Tallahassee, and Joe Fracassi of Erie, Pa., salvaged two firsts for Florida State. Sebring won the discus throw with a mighty heave of 135 feet 13 1/2 inches that set a new school and track record for the event. Fracassi tied with Colvin and Cates of Duke for first place in the pole vault with a new school record leap of 12 feet.

## POSS WINS DASHES

Speedy Henry Poss paced the Blue Devils both in number of events won and in the record breaking derby, taking firsts 220 and 100 yard dashes and in the broad jump. He set new track standards in the 100 and the broad jump.

Tommy Reeves of Duke was credited with two individual victories, the 120 high hurdles and 220 low hurdles, setting a new record in the former. Other record breakers for the Blue Devils were Bob Marshall and Henry Bullock who tied in the mile run, John Tate in the 880, Tom Sanders in the two-mile, James Lawrence in the shotput and the Duke mile relay team of Chamberlain, Anderson, Grisso and Tate.
