A pronounced depth in the field events proved the big difference yesterday as powerful Loyola University of the South scored a 19-52 victory over the Plorida Stlae backmen on thep west campus oval.

In addition to setting two track records—in the shot put and discus—Ray Rocker of Loyola racked up a third first place in the Jave-lie lin throw to pace the New Orleans Wolfpack with 15 points.

Freshman Bill Wagoner of FSU, double winner for the second successive week in the half-mile and mile, recorded a track record in the latter event with a pace-1 seting 4:36.8. He was hard-pushed to take the 880 in a slower 5 2:06.5.

Wagoner, however, was handle capped as were all the runners, by an over-hard track and the stiff wind blowing against each distretch drive.

POSTON GETS REVENGE

These conditions didn't visibly hamper Seminole captain John Poston who reversed his loss to Loyola's Leithman in the Florida Relays, by defeating Leithman convincingly in the hundred and 1 220 yard dashes.

Fraundorfer won the broad jump with 21'9" and broke his own FSU record while finishing second in the shot put. He tosed the weight 43'5%".

Woody Parker continued his victory string in the 440 with a 51.5. effort that established a track record, besting Woody's own mark. here by one-tenth of a second.
