FSU TRACK TEAM LOSES

Loyola Scores 76-54 Win Here

Led by Ray Rocker's field records in the shot put and javelin,
the Loyola College Wolfpack
swept past FSU's Seminoles 7654 in a track meet on the brickred oval of West Campus yesterday.

Running to the form forecast by coach Kenneth Miller, the Seminoles stayed close to Loyola in the flat races and gained in the hurdles as freshman Weston Minton won with record-breaking times of 15.2 and 24 flat.

But in the field—as predicted— FSU's versatile sophomore Carlos Fraundorfer carried the load and still had to take a back seat to the powerful Rocker.

Though Fraundorfer scored 13 points, Rocker had 15, with record firsts in the shot put—48'—and the javelin—191' 1½"—and a win in the discus too.

In addition to four field events, Fraundorfer entered the hundred yard dash and ran a close secon to Loyola's Newman.

Minton, state champion as a Jacksonville prep star last year, finally flashed the form expected of him as he raced to double in the hurdles. In the 110 highs he shared first place with Heap of Loyola. FSU's Jule Hurst, who held the previous school record of 15.3, ran a fast third.

In the 220 low hurdles Minton closed strong to best Loyola's favored Baradel. He shaved a half-second from the FSU mark of 24.5 set by Rog Bowman in 1950.

State's Woody Parker fought off Wolfpack freshman Erwin Caswell to win the open quarter in 50.9. Then the situation was reversed in the 220 yard dash. In the final mile relay Caswell clashed with Parker on the anchor lap and triumphed by halfa-step in a thrilling finish. Captain Dick Mize's fast third lap had put the Indians into contention after a slow start.

Loyola's Ronald Hymel and State's Joe Fracassi renewed their rivalry in the pole vault and in a draw at 12' 6", well under their best. A strong head wind was a special hindrance in the vaulting.

FSU next goes on the road this week, meeting the Miami Hurricanes in Coral Gables Saturday.
