MACON, Ga.—Florida State's freshman-heavy track team captured all but one first place to thrash the Mercer Bears, 101-30, in the Seminoles' 1955 dual opener here yesterday.

FSU won 14 first places, nine seconds, and seven thirds in handing Mercer its worst defeat in seven meetings with FSU. State has a 6-1 lead in the series.

It was the second highest total ever recorded by an FSU track squad.

Freshman Jack Terwilliger of Dade City sparked FSU with 14½ points. Terwilliger won the 100 and 200-yard dashes, finished second in the broad jump, and anchored FSU's winning mile relay team.
