

MACON, Ga., April 7 (AP)—Florida State University took nine first places and Davidson College won six as the Floridians won today's triangular track meet at Porter Stadium here by a narrow margin of seven points. FSU scored 83 points, Davidson 76 and Mercer 34.

Phil Koonce, a Davidson senior from Tarboro, N. C. won the 100-yard dash in a fast 9.3. Koonce holds the Southern Conference titles in the 100 and 220.

Jim Terwilliger of FSU who placed a close second in the 100-yard dash beat out Koonce in his other specialty, the 220. Terwilliger ran the event in 21.5.

Pete Ashcraft, a Davidson junior from Massachusetts was one of the two double winners in the meet. Ashcraft, who holds Southern Conference mile and two mile championships, ran a 4:37 mile to win on a windwept track and also won the 800 with a 2:08 clocking.

Barney Davis of FSU also took two events. He jumped 22 feet 9 3/4 inches for his win in the broad jump and ran the 220 low hurdles in :25 for another first place. He also placed third in the 100-yard dash.

Davis was the high point man in the meet with 12. Koonce followed with 11 points made on one first and two second places and Ashcraft was third with his two first places and ten points.

Bill Weaver of FSU ignored a vicious cross wind and threw the javelin 100 feet, 5 inches.
