

ATHENS, Ga., April 21 (AP)—The Florida State Seminoles won a keenly contested triangular track and field meet today, amassing 64 1-3 points. Georgia Tech was second with 59 1-3 points and Georgia third with 46 1-3 points.

Speedster Jack Terwilliger of FSU was the day's individual scoring leader. He paced the visitors from Tallahassee with a first in the 220-yard dash, a second in the 100-yard dash and anchored FSU's winning 440-yard and one mile relay teams.

Georgia's Melvis Charles won the quarter mile in :49.2 to set a new school record. Tom Simonton of Georgia took the 100-yard dash in :09.8 to equal the school record.

Georgia's Bill Duckworth took the javelin event with a throw of 207 feet 2½ inches while teammate Bob Davis was first in the high jump with a leap of 6 feet 3 inches.
