Florida State's track team won its sixth meet of the season here last night with an 87-44 triumph over Loyola of New Orleans.

The Seminoles captured 10 first places to Loyola's five. Jack Terwilliger of Florida State was high point man for the night with 6 $\frac{1}{4}$  points, winning two firsts for the Seminoles and anchoring the mile relay team.

Five new records were set in the meet, three by Loyola and two by the Seminoles.

Jerry Heap, Loyola's hurdle specialist, set the low hurdles mark in 23.8. Then Heap broke his own high hurdles mark with a 14.8.

The other Loyola record breaker was Sam Ascari who broke his own broad jump mark when he jumped 22' 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Heap nailed two first places for Loyola, and Ascari also figured in two firsts, winning the broad jump and figuring in a three-way tie for first in the high jump.

Florida State took all three places in the 800 run when Loyola didn't have an entry for the event. The Seminoles also captured the final mile relay event in the same manner.
