

MONTGOMERY, Ala. (AP)—

The Seminoles of Florida State won the Coliseum relays for the second year in a row Saturday, scoring in nearly every event.

Florida State picked up most of its points in also-ran performances but Jim Casteel equaled the Coliseum record of 6.4 seconds in the 60-yard dash and won the broad jump with a leap of 22 feet 2 inches.

Vanderbilt's great mile miler, Fred Abington, took first place in the mile and two mile runs.
