

Florida State scored in 14 of 15 events and piled up six first places to successfully defend its team championship in the annual Florida AAU track and field championships here last night.

In one of the season's better showings by Coach Mike Long's Seminoles, FSU racked up 61-9-10 points to finish well ahead of runner-up Florida (29½) and the third-place Atlanta Striders (28). University of Georgia was fourth with 13½ points.

Other scores included Florida Freshmen, 7 2-5; FSU Frosh 6 8-15; Georgia Fresh 3, and South Georgia 2. Unattached entries scored 13½ points while Stetson failed to score.

Some 1,000 spectators watched eight records fall during the 15-event program, with the Seminoles getting three of them. Doyle Ruff of Orlando turned in a record 1:56.4 880-yard run. Kent Mills breezed two miles in a record 9:43.5, and Charles Drago threw the discus 154 feet, 10½ inches for a new record.

Buddy Fowikes, 32-year-old standout for the Atlanta Striders, was the meet's top scorer, winning firsts in the 100 and 200-yard dashes and the broad jump. Fowikes bettered his old state AAU record in the 220 with a 31.2-second time.

Possibly the meet's top single performance, however, was by Bill Duckworth of the Atlanta Striders. Duckworth hurled the javelin 241 feet, 1½ inches, some 30 feet better than the previous record set by Bob Allison in 1954.

Other records were smashed by

Florida's Henry Wadsworth, who competed unattached and cleared 14 feet, 1½ inches in the pole vault; Mike Conley, former FSU distance ace who ran the mile in 4:17.7, and Ron Ablowich of the Atlanta Striders, who traveled the 120-yard high hurdle course in 14.6 seconds.

Drago copped first places for the Seminoles in both the discus and shot. Ted Keen finished second in both the 100 and 220 and Jim Cassteel won the 440 and placed third in the 220.
