

GAINESVILLE—Florida State, which failed to finish among the top five teams in the 17th Florida Relays here yesterday, managed three second, two third and places in four relays.

Junior Don Ostergaard of Fort Myers set an FSU school record while finishing fourth in the shot put. Ostergaard heaved the shot 53 feet, 7 3/4 inches. Georgia Tech's Ed Nutting won it at 57 feet, 3/4 inches.

FSU's Steve Long was fourth in the high jump (6-2 1/2) and Kent Mills fourth in the two-mile run.

The Seminoles' mile relay team closed second behind Northeast Louisiana's sensational team. Seminole relay teams finished fifth in the sprint medley relay, the distance medley relay, and the 440-yard relay.
