

**MONTGOMERY, Ala. (AP) —**

Alabama, scoring in almost every event, won the annual Coliseum Relays tonight with a margin of only one and one-half points over second-place Auburn.

Jim Loftin of Escambia of Pensacola and John Dirkley of Tuscaloosa County set a new record of 6.3 seconds in the high school 60-yard dash.

Bill Davis of Florida State was second in the 880-yard run and Steve Long of Florida State tied for second in high jump at 6-1.

Davis, a promising sophomore, and Long, son of FSU Coach Mike Long and holder of the Seminole's high-jump record at 6-5 $\frac{1}{4}$ , were the only Seminoles to place in individual events.

Davis finished behind Northeast Louisiana's Jim Mouser in the 880 run and Long was topped by Alabama's Ronald Carter in the high jump. Carter jumped 6-2 and Long 6-1.

FSU finished third here last year after winning the team title in both 1958 and 1959.
