

MIAMI — Sweeping 14 of 15 first places, Florida State's track team celebrated its 1961 outdoor debut here yesterday with an overwhelming 102-29 dual triumph over Miami's Hurricanes.

Only twice in Seminole track history has an FSU team won more decisively. The 1959 Seminoles walloped Furman, 108-28, and the Seminoles routed Howard College, 109-17, back in 1950.

BIG EDGE

FSU has won its last seven meets with Miami and now owns an 8-4 edge in the state rivalry.

Junior Quentin Till of Coral Gables—home of the U of Miami—led Coach Mike Long's Tribe by winning the 220 and 440-yard dashes and running a leg on FSU's winning mile relay team.

FSU made clean sweeps of all points in four events—the high jump, 220-yard low hurdles, 440-yard dash, and 880-yard run. William Sharp gave Miami its only first place by taking the javelin throw.

The Seminoles set five meet records and junior Bill Welch of Jacksonville broke his own school record in the 120-yard high hurdles. Welch was timed in 14.8 seconds, one-tenth of a second faster

than his record set last year.

MEET RECORDS

Other meet records were established by Bill Davis in the 800, Herb Kraft in the broad jump, Jeff Clark in the discus, and Craig Johnson, Tom Houston, Davis, and Till in the mile relay.

Johnson also turned in a sharp 100-yard dash in 9.8 seconds. Team captain Don Ostergaard showed good form in winning the shot put at 52 feet, 7½ inches. Ed Hays cleared 13 feet, one inch in the pole vault.

FSU meets powerful Alabama in its next dual start, at Tallahassee March 23.
