

Florida State's track team entered two events and came up with two first places in the annual Optimist Relays at Hollywood Saturday night.

Seminole Coach Mike Long was pleased when junior Quentin Till of Coral Gables won the 440-yard run in 49.2 seconds. Till then anchored FSU's winning mile relay team that nipped Furman in the best race of the Hollywood Program.

Tom Houston, Terry Long, Bill Davis, and Till turned in a 3:19.7 time in edging Furman, Miami, and Florida. "It was a very satisfying victory," said Long, "because every man dueled it out. Till had one of the best anchors legs we have had in a long time."

Till had to overcome a slight lead that was handed to Furman's Olympic dash hopeful, Dave Segal of England. After following Segal's heels most of the way, Till passed the Furman flash with a quick burst just before they hit the finish line.

The Seminoles open their home schedule in a dual meet with tough Alabama here Thursday.
