

Showing tremendous strength in the dashes and relays, Florida State's track team defeated the University of Miami by a decisive 89½-55½ score yesterday afternoon.

The powerful running of Tallahassee's Jerry McDaniel was one of the biggest factors in the Seminole victory which saw eight meet records fall. McDaniel won the 220 and 440 and ran legs in two winning relay teams as FSU took 11 first places in the 17 event meet.

Miami came on strong in the distance and field events. One of the biggest upsets of the day occurred when Gene McCleary busted Al Williams in the discus with a heave of 153'-6". Williams was unbeatable in the shot put, however, and tossed it 55' 3" to set a meet record.

Bob Sable was a surprise winner for the Seminoles in the 100 yard dash, beating Hutch Johnson and Al Cato regarded as the top two FSU sprinters. FSU won all three places in both the 100 and 200.

Miami's Billy Payne was the only double winner besides McDaniel, taking firsts in both the one and two mile runs. FSU's Dick Roberts was second in both races.

A late attraction for the crowd of 1,000 which saw the Seminoles win their first dual meet of the season was the pole vaulting of Don Pharis. Pharis left the rest of the field behind at 11' 3" and went on to set a meet and school record with a leap of 14' 5¼".

Doug Ferry was also a record breaker for the Seminoles with a 38.9 clocking in the 330 yard intermediate hurdles, topping the meet school and track records.

Both the 440 and mile relay teams turned in record shattering performances with times of 41.6 and 3:20.4.
