The Seminoles swept the 100 yard dash for the third straight meet with chunky Al Cato doing the honors in 9.8, followed by Hutch Johnson and Bob Sable. All three FSU runners were timed in under 9.9.

Don Pharis reached a height of 14'6'4" in the pole vault to preak a school record in that event. Darryl Guthrie in the riple jump, and Floyd Lorenz n the high jump were ot herieminole winners.

Gamecock hurdler David Gatch won both the 120 highs and 330 intermediates, edging margins. Bob Crombie won the 880 for USC, J. R. Wilburn the javelin and Woody Chapman the broad jump.

Virtually the entire Seminole team will make the trip to Gainesville for the Florida Relays where competition is among the best in the country.
