

Neither rain nor South Carolina could stop Florida State's powerful track team yesterday as the Seminoles swept to their third convincing victory of the season, 91-54.

Coach Mike Long had predicted a close meet in the warm-up for tomorrow's Florida Relays in which the Seminoles will apparently get their first real test of the year.

However, distance man Dick Roberts came up with his best performance of the year winning both the mile and two mile. The two victories were for FSU in those events this year, and combined with the usual strong showing in the sprints and field events, pushed the Seminoles over the top when the meet was little over half finished.

Jerry McDaniel chalked up his usual victories in the 220 and 440, plus the opening leg on the 440 relay team, but the Tallahassee strider was edged out on the final leg of the mile relay by USC's Mike McGuinness. McDaniel turned in times of 21.9 and 48.4 in his two winning events.

Al Williams was the other double winner for FSU. Williams, coming ever closer to last season's record breaking form, threw the shot put 55' 10½ inches and the discus 153' 8½".

The Seminoles swept the 100 yard dash for the third straight meet with chunky Al Cato doing the honors in 9.8, followed by Hutch Johnson and Bob Sable. All three FSU runners were timed in under 9.9.

Don Pharis reached a height of 14'6¼" in the pole vault to break a school record in that event. Darryl Guthrie in the triple jump, and Floyd Lorenz in the high jump were other Seminole winners.

Gamecock hurdler David Gatch won both the 120 highs and 330 intermediates, edging FSU's Doug Ferry in the latter event by the smallest of margins. Bob Crombie won the 880 for USC, J. R. Wilburn the javelin and Woody Chapman the broad jump.

Virtually the entire Seminole team will make the trip to Gainesville for the Florida Relays where competition is among the best in the country.
