Powerful Southern Illinois pushed by the Florida State track team 80 to 65 here yesterday.

Southern set five track records in the meet, but had to win the last three events—the two-mile, triple jump, and mile relay — to overcome a 61-61 tie.

Olympian Oscar Moore led the parade, setting track marks in the mile (4:11.6) and the two-mile (8:54.7). The White Plains, N.Y., Negro just took off in the two mile, smashing the old record by over 44 seconds.

Shot - putter George Woods, NCAA indoor winner, set a new mark in the shot with a throw of 59'3½" and won the discus as well.

For the Seminoles, Steve Landis set a new mark in the 440 intermediate hurdles in a time of 53.8. Other record breakers were high jumper Tom Ashman at 6'8 3-8" and triple jumper John Vernon for S.I. at 49'8".

FSU sprinter Ken White won both the 100 in 9.6 and the 220 dashes. The Illinois sprin-

ters were "hurting" after an auto accident on the way down. Three of their men sat out the meet with minor injuries, giving the Seminoles the chance to sweep the sprints.

It was a meet in which Florida State could never come up with the big points to take the lead. FSU's Bud Manning lost the javelin by two feet. Hurdler Charley Vicker was battling for second place in the 440 immediate-hurdles when he fell down going over the last one.

Florida State lost the mile relay in an exciting race which saw S.I.'s outstanding 440 man Gary Carr pull ahead of FSU's John Brogle on the final straightaway. Brogle lost the half mile to S.I.'s Jeff Duxbury in almost similar circumstances.

It was a day of disappointment for the Seminole trackmen, who had hopes of upsetting the visitors. Sophomore javelin man Bud Manning threw a season best of 200'5", only to see Southern Illinois take the win. In the high jump he tied his best personal mark of 6-4, but finished a full three inches out of second place.

Florida State will compete next in the Florida Relays next Saturday in Gainesville. Southern Illinois will be at that meet, giving the Takabassie men another chance to beat S.I. in some of these events.
