Florida A&M's 440-yard relay team had the best time of the day Friday in qualifying for the finals of the Penn Relays.

Eugene Milton of A&M also qualified for today's finals in the 100-yard dash, and the Rattlers' 880-yard relay team qualified to continue today.

There were only four college individuals events — the 440-meter hurdles, broad jump, discus and hammer throw — on Friday's card.

Donald Smith of A & M placed fourth in the discus with a toss of 175'7". Florida State's Sid Gainey was fifth in the broad jump with a leap of 23'1½" and Steve Landis of FSU was fifth in the 400-meter hurdles with a :53.6 clocking.
