GREENVILLE, S. C. — Florida State tracksters picked up on first and three second places finishes in the annual News Piedmont Relays here Saturday.

The Seminole thinclads were in competition with 29 other universities from around the southeast—including Florida, Georgia, Georgia Tech, Clemson and Furman which was the host school for the one day meet. This was an individual meet and no team scores were awarded.

Bud Manning collected the Seminoles sole first in the javelin with a toss of 203 feet. FSU's Mike Kelly finished second in the 120 yard high hurdles and third in the 440 intermediate hurdles.

In the two mile run, FSU's Ken Misner was second with a time of 9:28.8. The Seminoles 440 relay squad of Greg Kaufman, Doug Brown, Steve Lewis and Andy Guy placed second.

Contestants were buffeted by strong winds, and this combined with cold temperatures, hampered many of the tracksters.

Florida State's next meet is Saturday in Gainesville for the Florida Relays.
