Without breaking any stop-watches or arousing dampened spectators, Tennessee's track team overpowered Florida State and the Quantico Marines last night in a dress rehearsal for the Southeastern Conference meet.

The Vols will be seeking their fifth straight SEC title at Tuscaloosa, Ala., Friday and Saturday.

Tennessee scored 95 points, more than the combined output of the Seminoles and Marines. Florida State tallied 44 and Quantico 39. Some 300 fans came to Tom Black Track despite the rain.

Tennessee won 13 events, claiming all seven firsts in the field. Quantico's Bill Clark, as near a sure-fire Olympian as there is at this moment, doubled in the mile and three-mile races.

Richmond Flowers won the high hurdles by matching his slowest time of the season, 14 seconds. Bill Skinner won the javelin with his poorest throw, 138 feet, 8 inches.

"I hope I saw a little hint that we are bouncing back from our mid-season slump," said U-T Coach Chuck Rohe. "I think we'll be OK by next weekend."

Three Vol milers, paced by Sam Rutherford, ran well. Chick McGeehan finished strong to take the 100 in 9.9, Tom Fisher looked good in taking the long jump. Gary Wagner had a crisp relay leg and came back to win the 220.

Hardee McAlhanev buzzed the four turns in 48.5 to finish far ahead in the 440.

Other Vol winners were Steve Owens (pole vault), George Jenson (shot put), Karl Kremser (high jump), Les Rager (discus), and Jeff Gabel (triple jump).

Tennessee took both the 440 and mile-relays.

"I was proud of our milers," said Rohe, referring to Rutherford's 4:11.1 for second with Dickie Kleier and Tony Masi right on his heels, also under 4:12.

Clark, second in the recent Boston Marathon and a record-setter in two races last week in the Quantico Relays, posted an ordinary 4:09.5 in the mile and a Tom Black Track record 14:05.3 in the three-mile.

Clark is a long-distance runner who logs at least 100 miles in practice 52 weeks a year.

Florida State's lone winner was Mike Kelly in the intermediate hurdles. Marine John Tillman won the 880.

Thanks to Wagner's opening leg, the U-T 440 relay team won easily enough. Gary, Gee Lee, McGeehan and Flowers logged 11 flat, a half-second ahead of the Seminoles.

Jim Smeltzer and Audry Hardy had strong splits in the mile relay (won in 3:12.6). Gary Womble and McAlhanev were their partners.

**VOL CAPTAIN** Larry Kelly missed the meet on orders of trainer Mickey O'Brien. Kelly had a sore throat and O'Brien didn't want to battle the bad weather with the SEC test com-

ing up Saturday in Tuscaloosa.

**SKINNER** was very disappointed with his best throw. "My arm feels like one big toothache," said Bill, who has been going backwards since the season-opening throw of 247-3 in the Florida Relays.

**THE VOLS** dominated the dashes, high jump, discus and triple jump. McGeehan, Wagner and Flowers ran 1-2-4 in the 100. Wagner and Lee were 1-2 in the 220 and McAlhanev and Womble were 1-2 in the 440.

**KREMSEK** and Lonnie Hance placed 1-2 in the high jump. Rager and Tom Carmichael were 1-2 in the discus and Gabel and Chris D'Orazio did the same in the triple jump.

**DR. TOM SCOTT** won the exhibition for men over 40, running 5:25.7. Terry Hull of Knoxville Track Club was first in the women's 220 (24.7). Roy Reeves won the exhibition quarter, Carroll Thrift took the 100 and Roger Neiswender the exhibition high hurdles. Gordon Wilson was the mile winner.
