

TUSCALOOSA, Ala. (AP) —

The University of Florida had eight first place finishers to ease by Florida State for the championship of the third annual Gulf Coast five-way track and field meet here Saturday.

The Gators chalked up 79½ points to 70½ for second place FSU. Auburn finished third with 57 points, host Alabama had 54 and Mississippi State 11.

John Morton was Florida's only double winner of the day, taking first in both the discus and shot put. John Parker and Bob Lang set meet records for the Gators. Parker got his with a 4:10.5 mile run and Lang turned in a 1:53.2 in the 800.

FSU Mike Kelly had a record-tying time of 14.2 in the high hurdles. He also picked up a win for FSU in the intermediate hurdles.
