KNOXVILLE, Tenn. — Florida State's Mike Kelly turned in the fastest intermediate hurdles time in the world this year yesterday when he toured the 440-yard distance in 50.2 seconds while competing in a qualifying heat of the NCAA Track and Field meet here.

The Winter Park senior went into this afternoon's semifinals with a time which is just off the national record of 49.6.

Kelly also would have qualified for the high hurdles semifinals had it not been for a judge's decision. He ran the highs in 13.8 against the wind only to be disqualified when a judge ruled that his trailing foot didn't pass four inches above the ninth hurdle.

Last year in the NCAA high's, Kelly finished fifth, also with a 13.8 clocking.

Seminole Coach Mike Long says he thinks, "Mike can run better in the intermediate today.

"However, there is always the constant possibility that he will hit a hurdle or fall."

Kelly's semifinal heat today is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. and he must finish among the top four to qualify for Saturday's finals.

Florida's Jerry Fannin, the Southeastern Conference champion, competed in Kelly's

intermediate heat yesterday and failed to qualify.

Seminole sprinter Doug Brown failed to qualify yesterday while the other Florida State entry, distance man Ken Misner, competes in the three-mile race Saturday at 5:50 p.m.

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. — Florida State's Mike Kelly Friday qualified for the 440-yard intermediate hurdles finals at the NCAA Track and Field Championships.

Kelly placed second in his heat with a clocking of 51.2. He had breezed into the quarterfinals with a 50.2 performance Thursday — the fastest time in the world this year in his event.

"Mike ran a very smart race Friday," said Florida State coach Mike Long. "You don't have to set any world records to qualify. He was running to place, not win."

Kelly went out hard, led after about 300 yards, then coasted to the second-place finish.

"Judging from the field that qualified," said Long, "Mike should have a very good chance of winning the event."

Today's finals will be run around 5:30. Another FSU

runner, Ken Misner, competes for the three-mile title today at 5:50.

San Jose State sprinter John Carlos whipped defending champion Lennox Miller in the 100-yard dash final in the disappointing time of 9.2 seconds and Kansas piled up points in the team race.

Miller is from Southern California.

Carlos, who had promised to bid to become the first runner ever to crack the 9-second barrier, shook his head in frustration after the time was posted.

However, he still has a shot at a world record in the 220 Saturday.

The controversial speedster, booted out of the Olympic Village last fall, also anchored the San Jose State 440 relay team which set the pace in the trials with a 38.3 clocking only two-tenths of a second off the world record.

Kansas jumped into the team lead with the help of a 1-2 sweep in the shotput, where Karl Salb won with a toss of 64 feet, 9 inches and Steven Wilhelm was second with 63-6½, and with Stan Whitley's second-place in the long jump with a leap of 26-7.

Whitley was beaten by Jerry Proctor of Redlands, who surprised his big school rivals with a leap of 26-11¾.

Kansas, expected to battle San Jose State for the team title, is counting on distance ace Jim Ryun in Saturday's 13-event finale. Ryun, the world record holder in the mile, will try for an unprecedented sweep of the mile and the three-mile.

Kansas piled up 30 points after the first two days of the meet, with Oregon State second at 20, Villanova third with 17, and San Jose State fourth with 16.

Tennessee had 14, Washington State 14, UCLA 13 and Oregon 12.

The first four finishers in the meet are named All-American. Kelly had never been disqualified before Thursday in his career when he was declared so in the high hurdles.

Kelly suffered a slight hamstring muscle pull with

about 180 yards left in the race, leaving him in doubtful status for next week's AAU meet.

FSU's Ken Misner dropped out of the three-mile run after about two miles.

San Jose State won the team title, scoring 48 points to 45 for second-place Kansas. Washington State and Oregon tied for third with 40 points.

Sophomores Curtis Mills of Texas A&M and Marty Liquori of Villanova scored stunning upsets that high-lighted the meet. Mills broke the world

record in the 440-yard dash, with a clocking of 44.7 seconds to nip Olympic champion Lee Evans of San Jose State.

Liquori uncorked a courageous finishing kick and whipped world record-holder Jim Ryun of Kansas by 10 yards in the mile, winning in 3:57.7.

John Carlos, who won the 100 in 9.2 Friday, anchored San Jose State's winning 440-yard relay team and thundered to a 10-foot triumph in the 220, winning in 20.2.
