Rod Milburn--Olympian--Hurdles Winner--Preliminary today.

"I'm running all right; as long as I can keep winning I'm not going to complain. I only worked out seriously a couple of days before coming here."

"Pro football is definitely on my mind. I played as a receiver last fall at Southern, but part of our season was cancelled because two students were killed in a disturbance there. The Rams have drafted me, and if the money is good, I want to play next season."

Dan Taylor--Eddyville High School--120-Yard Hurdles Winner.

"The :14.3 I ran today is my best. Before that, :15.0 was all I could do. Just running here before this great crowd really pumped me up. I've been killing myself trying to reach the :14's. This was a perfect race for me. I knew if I was going to win I had to beat Ken Jackson (of East Waterloo) out of the blocks."

"Last summer I broke all the toes on my left foot as a result of a car accident. I was on crutches for 11 weeks and missed our first three football games. The doctor didn't want me to play basketball, but I did anyway."

Bowling Green's Team--Winner of the Four-Mile Relay in New Drake Record.

Steve Danforth--"I don't like to take the lead until the last lap. I'm able to relax that way. This was by far and away the best we've run together."

Bruce Vermilyea--"The reason for the fast time was the great competition here."

Coach--"We're running downtown to get back to our motel."

Dave Wottle--"We had no basic strategy for the race, we just wanted to stay close. Our guys just went out and did the job--it's as simple as that."

"I had no worry about the outcome although the competition was good. I was surprised though at how we stayed up front throughout the entire race. Usually we come from behind."

"This race won't hurt us at Penn tomorrow. Our plane leaves at 3:15 so we should get a good night's sleep. I feel very loose and am optimistic that we can reach 16:13."

"I'm not sure if I'll stay around for the 1976 Olympics."

Marc Sakamoto--Winner of High School 100-Yard Dash (:09.8) 5'8", 150 lbs.

"I'm satisfied, although I had hoped to beat :09.8 today. I think I ran better this morning in the prelims."

"The two guys I kept my eyes on were Norman Gaut (Des Moines Tech) and Fred Parks (Davenport Central)."

"Last year as a junior I placed fourth here. My best time last year was :10.0, but I've been able to improve through a five weight program and running in summer track meets. I think I am a much more mature runner this year, but I don't know how far I can improve."

"Iowa and ISU have talked to me, but I haven't heard from Drake. I will decide on a college after the track season is over."

"I'd rather run track than play football (he's a split end), but I might play football for a major school if they let me run track too. I can't see breaking my neck for a small school."

Paul Craig--Anchor on Texas Two-Mile Relay Team.

"I'm the worst of our runners, and although I'd rather come from behind. I was really gald to have that lead when I got the baton."

Bill Goldapp--Ran 2nd leg for Texas

"We were disappointed that we lost to Illinois at the Kansas Relays last week. We dropped the baton after being five Yards ahead midway through the race."

Al Fuerbach--2nd Shot Put

"I have no excuses, my coordination was off as a result of too much rest. I haven't worked out much regularly."

"I'm really not thinking about Montreal in 1976. I just want to compete against the best shot putters internationally."

George Woods--Shot Put

"I started off well today but after my good first throw my technique fell apart. It's just too early for me to throw long, I'm just not in shape yet."

"I really enjoy competition and I feel stronger than last year. It's funny but after an Olympic year, I always feel flat. I seem to loose some of my desire momentarily--I've got to get meaner."

"I'm still thinking about 1976. Turning professional is of no interest to me."

Jim Bolding--Finished 2nd in 440-Yard Hurdles Invitational.

"My steps were sloppy today and the wind bothered me on the back stretch. I took an extra step between the hurdles on the back stretch because of the wind and it cost me."

"I've missed the last 10 days of workouts because of a pulled muscle, but I don't want to take anything away from Cronholm. He's in better shape and has run more races than anyone else. The win favors Cronholm's style because he naturally takes shorter steps."

"I just finished graduating from Brigham Young one week ago when I was notified about running here at Drake. Taking that into consideration I was satisfied with the way I ran."

"The wind today reminded me of Munich."

"I am going to teach at Washington State U."

"Competition is competition wherever you go. I still have a lot of desire to do well. In fact I want to try and get that gold metal in 1976."

Bill Rea--Pittsburgh, Long Jump Winner.

"This is the first decent meet I've been in all year. The rest have either been too cold or too wet. I'm a warm weather jumper, so by the time the NCAA and AAU meets come, I should be ready. I think that I'm capable of doing 27 feet or over this summer. I really couldn't get loose today and as a result I was slow down the runway."
