

## FSU relay wins event in a hurry

CHAMPAGNE, Ill. — Florida State University's 240-yard shuttle hurdle relay team highlighted the Seminoles' second day in the Illinois USTFF Invitational Track Meet Saturday.

FSU won the event in 28.8 seconds, one of the nation's fastest times this year. John Citron, Mike Woods, Gary Bassa, and Mike Roberson comprised the team.

Phares Rolle swept to second place in the pole vault with a jump of 16 feet. Larry Sayers tied for second in the high jump with a leap of 6-foot-10.

Roberson paced three Seminole finishers in the high hurdles with a third place, photo-finish in 7.3 seconds. Citron finished fourth and Woods sixth. Roberson had led all qualifiers going into the finals with a University of Illinois Field House record of 7.1 seconds.

Jesse Forbes, top qualifier in the 60-yard dash with a 6.2-second time, false started and was disqualified in the finals.
