FSU gets a first, 3 seconds at meet

LOUISVILLE — Florida State's track team chalked up a first and three seconds Saturday night in the Mason-Dixon Games here.

The Seminoles, who ran into some tough luck Friday night with their mile relay team at the Millrose Games, won Saturday's mile relay. Mike Roberson, who missed Friday's relay because of sickness, ran the opening leg in a blistering 46.9 to give FSU a 30-yard lead. Ron Nelson, Palmer Simmons and Walter McCoyy coasted in from there.

On Friday Robb Gomez was pressed into emergency duty because of Roberson's injury. He ran the an-

chor leg as FSU finished fourth.

Gomez came back Friday to finish in 1,000 meters

with a 2:26.3, behind Virginia's Greg Canty.

Roberson also came back to finish second in the 60 meters to Harvey Glance. Roberson's time was: 6.69.

McCoy, meanwhile, finished second in the 500 meters behind Bennie Brown of Athletes in Action. Mc-Coy's time was 1:03.7.

Florida State's Rose Giampalmo, running in a women's mile in which Brenda Webb set a meet record of 4:39.8, finished sixth in 5:06.8.
