

FSU qualifies 2 more for NCAA

GAINESVILLE — Herb Wills ran an NCAA-qualifying time of 14:00.1 in winning the 5,000-meter event at the Florida Fasttimes Indoor Track Invitational.

Phillip Rolle qualified for the nationals in the 500-meter. He finished in 1:03.03. Rob Gomez, who has been injured for most of the season, missed qualifying in the 1,000-meters by 3/10 of a second. The All-American ran a 2:24.86.

Ronnie Treadway finished second with 8:27.55 in the 3,000-meter; Bobby Shackelford, representing the Florida State Track Club, ran the 1,500-meter in 3:55.22; Lenox Jackson won the long jump with a leap of 21 feet, 11½ inches; Sam Gates finished fourth in the high jump with a jump of 6-foot-8.

The Seminoles have qualified six individuals and a relay squad to compete at the NCAA Indoor Championships March 13 and 14 in Pontiac, Mich.
