

FSU edges Florida at track meet

GAINESVILLE — Ronnie Taylor won the 200-meters and 400-meters races for Florida State as it scored 68 points to beat Florida and Georgia in a three-way track meet.

The Gators finished second with 64 points and the Bulldogs were third with 59 points.

Taylor won the 200 in 21.13 and the 400 in 48.52 while Herb Wills won the 5000-meters in 14:19.3.
