MEMPHIANS ARE BEATEN

Three tournaments in the United States Volleyball Championships at Memphis Navy drew near a close last night. Finals are slated for this morning at Millington's North Side Drill Hall.

Florida State, 1955 champs and top seeded in the collegiate tourney, beat University of Kansas, 15-6, 15-7, last night to take first place in the winners bracket.

Chicago Team Advances

George Williams College of Chicago took first in the losers bracket by downing Union College of Schenectady, N. Y., 15-8, 15-7.

Williams takes on Kansas at 8:45 this morning to determine which team will play Florida State for the collegiate title in this double elimination affair.
