BEATEN BY GEORGE WILLIAMS CLUB

The University of Scranton was eliminated from the College Division of the National Volleyball Championships by George Williams College of Chicago this morning at the Watres Armory.

The U of S, however, also is entered in the Open Division and will start its bid there tonight at 9:45 when it meets Chicago YMCA.

Scores of Scranton's matches this morning with George Williams were 15-7, 15-8. The match was in the losers bracket, as both teams were beaten yesterday in opening matches.

After bowing to Washburn College, Topeka, Kan., 15-9, 11-15, 10-8 yesterday at noon, the Royals rallied later to down Broome Tech, Binghamton, N.Y., 15-5, 15-8 in its first losers' bracket test, and then remained in the running by conquering University of Pittsburgh, 15-5, 5-15 and 15-10.

Florida State defeated Broome Tech, 13-1, 15-7, before bowing to University of Kansas, 15-8, 10-15, 15-9, to drop into the losers' bracket. Kansas gained the quarterfinals by defeating Washburn, 9-15, 17-15, 15-5.
