

FSU men swim past South Carolina

Led by sophomores Steve Albritton and Keith McConnell, the Florida State men's swim team downed South Carolina 69-44 Saturday at the Union Pool.

McConnell set a school record of 1:53.7 in the 200-backstroke and was also on the winning 400-medley relay team. Albritton won the 50 and 100-meter freestyle. Kevin Connell was

also a double winner in the 200-individual medley and 200-breaststroke.

meter diving and Gigi Sapper won the 3-meter diving.
