

## FSU swimmers top Indian River

Florida State's men and women swam to victories over Indian River Community College Saturday at Florida State.

The men won 72-41, while the women triumphed 75-56.

Indian River brought a three-time and defending national junior college champion to FSU, and it was only the second time in seven meetings that FSU has come away with a win.

Double winners for FSU were Kim Averill, Terri Miller and Lisa Nencioni. The women are now 9-2, with the final dual meet coming next weekend against South Florida. The win assured the best dual meet record in the women's history, with the previous best being 8-4 in 1976-77.

The FSU men won 10 of the 13 events to win the meet handily.
