

FSU swimming teams beat Daytona Beach

It may sound like a conspiracy, but the Florida State men and women's swimming teams each had meets with Daytona Beach Community College squads Thursday. And when the competitions were over, the scores were FSU men 76, Daytona Beach 37; FSU women 76, Daytona Beach 37.

For the men, Florida State swept the 400 individual medley (Dan Seymour, first; Craig Teeters, second); 1-meter diving (Randy Chambers, first; Craig Lindell, second); 100 butterfly (Sam Sieple, first; John O'Mahon, second); 100 backstroke (Jim Hamilton, first; Bill Reid, second); 3-meter diving (Craig Lindell, first; Randy Chambers, second).

The Lady Seminoles won eight of 13 events. Double winners were Terri Brown in the 100 butterfly and 200

freestyle and Tanya Hanson in the 50 and 100 freestyle.

The men's team evened its record after losing to the University of Georgia last week. The women are undefeated in four meets, having defeated Alabama, Auburn, Brenau and Daytona Beach.
