

Three FSU divers qualify

ATHENS, Ga. — Three more Florida State divers qualified for the NCAA Regional Meet, at the Southern Intercollegiate Championships this weekend, to bring the total to six — a new school record.

The regional meet will be in Gainesville March 9-10.

Jane Alexander qualified in the 1- and 3-meter events and also set FSU records in those events. She was fifth in the 1-meter with 408.65 points and in the 3-meter, Alexander accumulated 470.00 points to finish third.

David Lehman was third in the 1- and 3-meter events. His 473.85 in the 1-meter and 502.8 in the 3-meter qualified him for regionals in both events.

The other regional qualifier was Susie Hahn. She qualified in the 1-meter with 390.75 points and a seventh-place finish. Hahn also was seventh in the 3-meter with 404.80 points.

The three FSU divers who previously qualified, but didn't participate in this meet, were Chris McGregor, Patsy O'Toole, and Chris Creutzinger. All qualified for both boards.

Suzanne Bishop was eighth in the 1-meter with 389.80 points and 10th in the 3-meter with 379.65.

Phillip Hahn placed fourth in the 1-meter with 432.85 points and 3-meter with 403.20.

Larry Hoke was seventh in the 1-meter with 366.30 and in the 3-meter with 339.15.
