

THE IMMEDIATE NEED

Following a four-day, six-meet Florida State men's swim team held on in the last event to defeat Alabama 11-105 and won a pair of victories for both the men's and women's teams over the Crimson Tide at the Jim Smith Aquatic Center on Friday.

The Lady Seminoles also defeated Alabama 11-06 to put their record on the year to 3-0.

In the men's meet, the Crimson Tide entered the meet heavily favored as it came off a 15th place finish at last year's NCAA Championships. But Florida State got off to a quick start by winning the first three events. The Seminoles effort was keyed by sophomore Vance Lathursley who swam seven seconds under his previous personal best in upset Alabama All-American Bruce Lennard in the 500, as he swam to a 21:10.4 time.

Florida State also was aided by the diving of senior Benoit Seguin who won both the one and three meter diving events. In winning both events with scores of 327.225 in the one meter and 321.30 in the three meter, Seguin became the first Seminole in two years to qualify for the NCAA Championships.

Before FSU's early lead, the defending Southeastern Conference Champions fought back to cut the lead to just 10 points going into the final event of the day, the 400 free relay. Florida State's team of Mike Lockhart, Ryan Aycock, Charlie Rose and Kirk Laing came in second to preserve Florida State's biggest victory in the last decade. FSU raised its record to 2-1, while Alabama fell to 0-1.

"It was a step in proving to the nation that we're a team to be reckoned with," FSU co-head coach Bill Smith said. "It will catch the attention of a lot of people when they pick up the paper out on the West Coast."

The Florida State women's team pulled a few surprises of their own to pull the second upset of the day. Freshmen Kathy Jackson and sophomore Kathy Turner went 1-2 in the 200 fly to key the Lady Seminole victory. Jackson swam to a 2:03.45 to finish ahead of Turner at 2:10. "These were a pair of excellent early season times," FSU co-head coach Terry Hall said. Other Florida State winners included Merrin Ingram in the 1000 free, Susan North in the 200 free, Stacia Lyons in the 50 free, Alison Harvey in the 400 free and Colleen Martin in the 200 breast.

"It was great to win these two meets," Hall said. "Our goal was to win two of the four against Alabama this week and Georgia next week."

With early season victories over Miami, Texas and now Alabama, the Lady Seminoles will face Georgia next Friday at home. The meet is scheduled to begin at noon.
