

■ Florida State is one of five host sights for the 1992 NCAA Zone B Diving Championship which will be held this weekend at the Bobby E. Leach Center. The best divers in the region and the country will begin qualifying at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. today and complete the session at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. on Saturday.

FSU's hopes will be riding on **Paul Spray** and **Rob Caicedo**, who turned the ACC upside down with a 1-2 finish at the ACC Championships. All-American Spray suffered his only loss this season on the 1-meter board which came at the hands of Miami's **Dean Panaro**, who is the returning NCAA Champion on 1-meter, and the runner-up on 3-meter. **Teri Lukes** will represent the FSU women.

The top nine combined men's scores and the top seven combined women's scores will qualify for the NCAA meet.

■ The University of Miami got first-place individual performances Friday by **Betsy Girvan** and **Dean Panaro** to dominate the first day of the NCAA Zone 5 Diving Meet at the Bob Leach Center.

Both Girvan and Panaro qualified for the NCAA Championships.

Girvan beat **April Tassi** of the University of Maryland 427.50 to 402.25 on 10 dives off the 1-meter board. Panaro, the NCAA defending national champion, beat **Jason Thompson** of the University of Florida 579.45 to 541.05 for 11 dives off the 3-meter board.

Phoebe Mills, who won an individual Olympic gold medal in gymnastics in 1988, finished 32nd in the field of 37 women, with a score of 305.40.

In today's competition, the men will start out on the 1-meter board, followed by the women at 3 meters.

■ Florida State's **Paul Spray** will make his second consecutive trip to the NCAA Diving Championships, after qualifying for the event with a fourth place finish in Saturday's men's 1-meter diving competition.

Last year Spray finished 12th on the 1-meter board and 19th on the 3-meter at the NCAA Championships.

On the second and final day of qualifying for the NCAA Championships, the University of Miami captured victories in both the men's 1-meter diving and women's 3-meter diving events.
