Girvan beat April Tassi of the University of Maryland 427.50 to 402.25 on 10 dives off the 1-meter board. Panaro, the NCAA defending national champion, beat Jason Thompson of the University of Florida 579.45 to 541.05 for 11 dives off the 3-meter board.

Phoebe Mills, who won an individual Olympic gold medal in gymnastics in 1988, finished 32nd in the field of 37 women, with a score of 305.40.

In today's competition, the men will start out on the 1-meter board, followed by the women at 3 meters.
