

FSU Girls Win; Preps Are 4th

MIAMI — Annette Luthringer's state record javelin throw carried Florida State to the championship of the women's Region 4 AAU track meet here Saturday.

A Tallahassee four - women - team of high school students finished fourth, spurred on by a first place victory in the 100 - yard dash by Leon's Bonnie Smith.

Luthringer's state record throw of 127 feet was also a school record and preceded her third place finish in the discus won by FSU's Peggy Reed.

The Seminoles also picked up a first place performance from Laura Ledbetter in the

880 - yard run and four second place finishes.

Smith led the four students with an 11 second clocking in the 100 and a second place 25.0 time in the 220 - yard dash.

Leon schoolmate Lisa Kinch finished fourth in the 880, while Rickards' Sharon Bradford and Kathy Herring placed third and sixth respectively in the 440.

Rose Benoit led the FSU second place honors with finishes in the mile and the javelin. Reed took second in the shot and Sharp placed second in the high jump.

Marilyn Williams, Susan Hagler, Reed, and Sharpe came back to set a school record in the 440 - yard relay with a time of 51.3. It was good for second place.

Vickie Smith rounded out the FSU scoring with third place finishes in the 100 - meter hurdles and the shot put.
