

FSU record is broken

BATON ROUGE, La. — Freshman Warren Miller set a Florida State school record with a 1:11.0 time in the 600-yard run at the LSU-USTFF Classic here Saturday night.

In another meet at the Mason Dixon Games in Louis-

ville, Kentucky, Pharres Rolle finished second in the pole vault with a jump of 17 feet behind Dave Roberts.

Miller's time also qualified him for the NCAA finals, and was a fieldhouse record at LSU.

Tyrone Frederick won the 880 with a 1:54.5, and the Seminoles also placed first in the mile relay. The team of David Williams, Marvin Dixon, Vesco Bradley, and Miller won that event with a 3:17.1. It was also a fieldhouse record.

Earl Caruthers finished second in the 1,000 yard run with a 2:12.2 and Bradley was second in the 440 with a 48.8 timing.

Gary Bassa placed third in the 60-yard high hurdles with a 7.4, and Jesse Forbes finished fourth in the 60-yard dash with a 6.3.
