

## FSU women thinclads dominate USTFF meet

MONTGOMERY, Ala. — Florida State ran away with the women's competition in the U.S. Track and Field Federation national indoor meet here Friday.

FSU scored 86 points to 44 for second-place Tennessee State.

Harvey Gance's record performance in the long jump and first place finish in the 60-yard dash, combined with a new quarter mile record set by Willie Smith, led Auburn to a lopsided victory in the men's competition.

Judges unanimously chose Gance as the outstanding male athlete. For the best performance in the women's competition they picked Nancy Shafer of the Florida Track Club, who won the women's mile and two-mile events.

With all but four of the 17 events completed in the men's division, Auburn had 81 points and the closest competitor, Alabama, had 34.

After nine women's events, the Lady Seminoles had two first place finishes, three seconds, two thirds, a fourth and a fifth.

The two FSU winners were the two-mile relay team and 880 runner Rosemarie Giampalmo.

Giampalmo ran 2:09.97 to win the 880, then anchored the mile relay team that won with a 9:25.20 time.

Joining here were Beverly Cox, Leslie Sullivan and Nancy McCormack.

The Olympic gold medalist's two first-place finishes and a winning performance by James Walker, who equaled the meet record in the 60-yard high hurdles, put Auburn well out in front in the team scoring.
