# Texas runners top FSU

AUSTIN, Tex. — More than 150 colleges and universities from all over the country sent athletes to the prestigious track and field meet, but Florida State's entries found out why they call it the Texas Relays.

Those Texans know how to perform in their backyard. They kept the Seminoles from first place finishes in two

relay events.

FSU's 1,600-meter relay team ran the second fastest time in the school's history but it was good enough only for second place to Texas A&M. The Seminole sprint medley relay team finished third behind Texas Southern and the University of Texas.

In other events, FSU's Leon Hutchins triple jumped 50 feet, four inches to finish fifth. Former Seminole discus thrower Brad Cooper came in third with a heave of 192-3.

The 1,600-meter relay team (Ron Nelson, 46.9; Reggie Ross, 46.5; Palmer Simmons, 46.8; and Walter McCoy, 45.4) was clocked in 3:06.0. The Seminoles' sprint medley team of Mike Roberson, Kevin Johnson, McCoy and Simmons was clocked in 3:18.6.
