Four Florida State women place at track championships

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. — Four members of Florida State's second-place NCAA women's track and field team placed at the T.A.C. Championships last weekend in Indianapolis. The championships were not restricted to collegiate performers.

Junior Randy Givens took fourth place in the 200 meters and fifth in the 100 meters. Her 200 meter time of 22.31 was her best ever.

Hurdlers Angela Wright and Ovrill Brown both recorded personal bests in their events. Wright finished fifth in the 400 hurdles with a 56.74 timing. Brown was eighth in 56.94.

High jumper Wendy Markham was eighth in her competition with a 6-0½ jump.

Freshman Brenda Cliette, who finished a surprising third at the NCAA championships in the 100 meters, failed to make the finals at this meet. However, she was one of several FSU athletes who were invited to participate on national teams this summer.

Givens headed the list of FSU athletes participating on those teams as she made the World University Games team, the World Championship Games Team and the Pan American Games team.

Cliette was invited to participate in the World University Games and the Pan American Games. Markham and Wright were invited to participate on the South squad of the National Sports Festival. Former FSU hurdler Tonja Brown was also invited to represent the South on the Sports Festival team.
