PHILADELPHIA — Randy Givens won the 100meter dash for the third-straight year, beating out Tennessee's Mary Bolden by .07, for Florida State at the Penn Relays on Saturday.

Givens finished in 11.52 and Bolden placed in 11.59.

FSU also had the third- and fifth-place finishers in the event. Brenda Cliette came in third in 11.63 and Michelle Finn tied for fifth with an 11.75 clocking.

Carla Borovicka was timed at 4:22.5 in the 1,500 meters to qualify her for the NCAA National Outdoors. FSU's distance medley relay team came in fourth in 11:08.00 to set a school record.

For the third consecutive year, Wendy Markham finished second in the high jump with a mark of 5 feet, 10 inches.

Florida State's 1,600-meter relay ran a 3:33.89 to come in second and the Lady Seminole 3,200-meter relay team was third in 8:43.83.

Joann Brown came in in 13.90 to place sixth in the Mobile Grand Prix 100-meter run.
