FSU team adds qualifiers

The Florida State men's track and field team added an individual and a relay to its list of qualifiers for the NCAA Indoor Track and Field Championships while competing in the Miller Light Invitational last weekend in Flagstaff, Ariz.

Junior Tom Stitt set an FSU indoor record in qualifying and taking first place in the high jump with a personal best 7-3½ performance.

In addition to Stitt, the 1,600-meter relay of Vince Washington, Clark Waddell, Carter Williams and Thomas Johnson qualified with a 3:05.00 clocking.

Only the Florida Fast Times meet in Gainesville remains this weekend before the Indoor National meet at the Carrier Dome in Syracuse, N.Y., on March 15-16.

Florida State has qualified five individuals and two relays for the meet.

The Lady Seminoles, defending indoor national champions, did not add any additional qualifiers at the Arizona meet. Michelle Finn, who had previously met qualifying standards in the 55 meters, swept the event with a season-best 6.74 clocking. Finn is the only individual qualifier for the women's team, which also has qualified its 1,600-meter relay.
