

Carr an NCAA qualifier

BATON ROUGE, La. — Florida State University's Larry Carr qualified for the NCAA Indoor Track and Field Championship with a vault of 17 feet, 3½ inches in the pole vault at the Louisiana State Invitational Indoor Track and Field Meet on Friday.

Carr finished second to teammate Tommy Reither, who won the event at the same height on fewer misses. Reither had already qualified for the NCAA meet earlier this year.

Former Florida State track team member Thomas Johnson, won the 800 meter in 1:49.82 which qualifies him for TAC in New York next week. Johnson is representing the Army but is training here in Tallahassee and is enrolled in Florida State's ROTC program.
