

Blake third in New York

NEW YORK — Florida State sophomore Arthur Blake finished third overall in the 55-meter high hurdles at the Mobil Indoor Track and Field Championships on Friday.

Blake was timed at 7.13 seconds, trailing the world's top-ranked hurdler, Greg Foster, who won in 6.93 seconds, and 1987 world-indoor champion Tonie Campbell, who finished second in 7.12 seconds.

Roger Kingdom, the 1984 Olympic gold medalist, was fifth, in 7.20 seconds.
